

## Abstract Submission Instructions

Thank you for your interest in submitting an abstract for the ANSER 2026 Conference. Please have the below information ready when you start the abstract submission process.

### 1. Personal Information

Complete all required fields marked with an asterisk (\*):

- **First Name**
- **Last Name**
- **Institution/Organisation**
- **Position**
- **Country**
- **Email Address**
- **Phone Number** (include international country code)

### 2. Submission Type

Select one of the following types of submissions:

- **Poster Presentation:** Present your research visually on an A0 poster (portrait orientation). Bring your printed poster; no on-site printing available. Poster presentations include a 3-minute pitch and discussion.
- **Individual Abstract:** 20-minute oral presentation followed by Q&A. Presentations will be grouped into thematic sessions.
- **Panel Discussion:** Multi-speaker session (75 minutes) moderated by one person. Include minimum 3 and maximum 4 speakers. Focus on interaction rather than consecutive presentations.
- **Workshop:** Interactive session (75 minutes) with experiential learning, practical exercises, and discussions. Include 1–2 moderators.

### 3. Conference Themes

Select a relevant theme for your abstract:

- SRHR in Humanitarian and Climate-Related Crises
- Narratives, Power Dynamics, and the Politics of SRHR
- Integration of SRHR in Primary Care and Health Systems

#### 4. Abstract Details

- **Title:** Maximum 150 characters.
- **Abstract Text:** Maximum 2000 characters. Include background, objectives, methods, results, conclusion, and policy recommendations (as applicable).

For panel discussions

- Moderator name, position, institution, country, and email
- Names, positions, institutions, countries, and emails of all speakers or co-moderators (min. 3 speakers and max. Of 4 speakers)

For workshops, also include:

- Moderator name, position, institution, country, and email
- Min 1 moderator and max 2 moderators.

#### 5. Submission Notes

- You may submit multiple abstracts; each abstract requires a separate form submission.
- All submissions must be in English.
- Ensure your abstract aligns with the conference themes and submission type.
