I am **Arifin Dwi Saputro**, a lecturer at Laboratory of Postharvest and Food Engineering, Department of Agriculture and Biosystem Engineering, Universitas Gadjah Mada, Indonesia. In 2011, I received VLIR-UOS scholarship to follow "The 1st

Edition of Cocoa and Chocolate 14 days' Workshop" organized by Laboratory of Food Technology and Engineering, Ghent University. The reason I attended this workshop was to improve my knowledge on cacoa and chocolate processing. Since Indonesia is the third largest cocoa producer in the world, the knowledge about this matter is very crucial for the Indonesian cocoa and chocolate



development. Through this workshop I was able to meet Prof. Koen Dewettinck who later on became my PhD promotor.

In 2013, I received a scholarship from Indonesian Endowment Fund for Education (LPDP) to pursue my PhD in Ghent University. I did my PhD at the Faculty of Bioscience Engineering, Laboratory of Food Technology and Engineering, which works comprehensively on cocoa and chocolate sector. This laboratory has, not only cocoa and chocolate processing machines, but also many types of sophisticated instruments for cocoa and chocolate studies/research. Under supervision of Prof. Koen Dewettinck, since October 2013, I conducted a research entitled "Structure-Function Relations of palm sap sugar in dark chocolate".

At the beginning of December 2017, I officially finished my <u>PhD study</u>. The knowledge that I obtained during my study in Ghent University is very valuable and beneficial for my professional career. In line with the purpose of my PhD study, after returning to Indonesia, I will transfer the knowledge and apply it to develop Indonesian cocoa and chocolate sector.

In the future, I aim to create a research collaboration (related to cocoa and chocolate) between Ghent University and Gadjah Mada University. I hope that the International Alumni Association can also initiate such kind of collaboration among countries, thus, we will have a stronger network and can grow together.

The answers to these challenges are not so easy to find, but at least one answer is an important one.



Passed events

Incheon Academy of Science and Arts' visit to Ghent University

On the 23rd and 24th of October, 2017, the International Training Centre welcomed a group of 78 students and 9 coaches (teachers, supervisors, vice-principal) from the Incheon Academy of Science and Arts (IASA). This elite South Korean high school organized a study tour in Europe and Ghent University had the honour of welcoming them first.

At Ghent University the students could participate in one of our four custom built modules: chemistry, ecology, computer programming and biotechnology. Each model consisted of two days of lectures and workshops. At the end of both days students received a certificate of participation. The coordination and organisation was done by the ITC. Lecturers from different UGent faculties participated in the visit. From the science faculty we could count on the assistance of Prof. dr. Bart Braeckman, dr. Liliana D'Alba and dr. Christophe Vieira. They gave tours of their respective labs and organised workshops for the module Biotechnology and Ecology. Prof. dr. Sandra Van Vlierberghe and Prof. dr. Filip Du Prez's teams created the entire Chemistry module, Including lectures and integrated practical exercisesAdditionally Prof. dr. ir. Joris Thybaut and Leen Brouns from the faculty of Engineering and Architecture provided their expertise respectively during the modules Biotechnology and Programming. Finally Prof. dr. ir. Jan Baetens represented the faculty of Bioscience Engineering during the Computer Programming module. The students of IASA enjoyed the experience and were thrilled by the demonstration given by several lecturers. In turn lecturers found it an interesting experience to present their research to a young enthusiastic public. In short it was an educational venture for all parties involved and we hope to see these students at one of the Ghent University faculties in a couple of years.

Visit of the Tajik delegation to Ghent University

The international Training Centre was selected to do a consultancy project from the Worldbank in Tajikistan.. For two years, the staff will give advice and will train teachers and students from Tajikistan in order to improve the agricultural higher education at their respective institutions.

The government of Tajikistan is currently implementing a World Bank funded project to increase the commercialization of farms and agri-business in selected areas of Tajikistan. In the context of the Agriculture Commercialization Project (ACP), the ITC is consulting on the curriculum modernization at the Tajik Agrarian University and two vocational training colleges for agriculture. From the 19th until the 25th of November, 2017, we welcomed the Tajik delegation to Ghent University. The Tajik delegation consisted of members of the Tajik ministry of education, ministry of agriculture and representatives of all three higher education institutes. The purpose of this visit was to give the delegation a view of the infrastructure and campuses related to agriculture education. This included a tour of different campuses belonging to the faculty of Bioscience Engineering such as the Coupure, Schoonmeersen and Gontrode campuses and the experimental farm in Bottelare. Additionally the faculty of Veterinary Sciences in Merelbeke and the Flemish research Institute for Agriculture, Fisheries and Food (ILVO) were visited.

On Thursday, November 23rd a formal signing ceremony took place at the Coupure campus of the faculty of Bioscience Engineering. At this ceremony the project contract and support letters were both signed by all partners involved. We were honoured to welcome the Tajik ambassador, his Excellency Dr. Rahmatullozoda Erkinkhon, the Pro-Vice Rector of Ghent University Prof. dr. Freddy Mortier and the Dean of the faculty of Bioscience Engineering Prof. dr. ir. Marc Van Meirvenne.





The entire delegation enjoyed the visit. They learned much of the way we conduct research and provide education and services at Ghent University. Their eagerness to implement the techniques and ideas acquired at Ghent University was apparent. In the coming months there will be more contact moments with our Tajik partners, including a visit of a multidisciplinary UGent delegation to Tajikistan at the start of 2018.

17 'highly cited researchers' in various life science domains at Ghent University

(28-11-2017) Thomson Reuters (now called Clarivate Analytics) launched this exclusive list in 2001, which is based on the highest amount of leading publications. To be recognised as a 'highly cited researcher', a scientist must have had a significant impact on the work of fellow scientists.

Ghent University has no less than 17 researchers with the Highly Cited status this year. This is a remarkably high number considering that there is a total of 40 Highly Cited researchers in Belgium.

For the **Agricultural Sciences field**, Wim Verbeke (agri-food market and consumer behaviour) was once again recognised as a Highly Cited researcher; his fellow bioengineers, Korneel Rabaey and Willy Verstraete, were recognised in the Environment/Ecology category.

Ghent University scores highly in US News ranking of global universities

(07-11-2017) Ghent University ranks 5th for the subject area Plant and Animal Sciences in the US News ranking of global universities. For **Agricultural Sciences** Ghent University ranked 6th. In both rankings Ghent University is the second European University.

The ranking of US News contains 1,250 top universities from the U.S. and 60 other countries.

The universities are ranked based on 13 indicators that measure their academic research performance and their global and regional reputations.

Indicators are among others the number of publications and international collaboration.

Four hundred of these are international master students and 300 are international doctoral students. Ghent is a dazzlingly authentic, multicultural and open-minded city with 300,000 inhabitants of more than 150 nationalities, of which 20% are students.

Professor Bernard De Baets receives honorary title 'Profesor Invitado' from the Cuban Minister of higher education



On 27 October, 2017, professor Bernard De Baets (Department of Mathematical Modelling, Statistics and Bioinformatics, faculty of Bioscience Engineering) received the honorary title of 'Profesor Invitado' at the Universidad Central "Marta Abreu" de las Villas (UCLV) in Cuba.

He received the title for his personal accomplishments, his renowned scientific and academic career and his active collaboration with the UCLV.

ERC Consolidator Grants: €630 million from the EU to 329 top researchers

The <u>ERC</u> has evaluated 2,538 research proposals this time, out of which 13% will be funded. Thirty-two percent of grants were awarded to female applicants. Two of those prestigious grants (of around 2 million Euro per person) have been awarded to 2 staff members of the Ghent University.


