# MOBILITY GRANTS

# MOBILITY GRANTS (1)

- Via UGent (central level) – deadline 31/01/2020
- Via FBE (faculty level) – several deadlines in 2020

# MOBILITY GRANTS (2)

- Mobility for **courses in Europe** (min. 3 months)
  - Only for international joint masters
  - Only **if no EU scholarship**:
    - **Erasmus+ credit mobility scholarship** (via UGent)
      - Group 1 (Denmark, Sweden):  
€379/month
      - Group 2 (Austria, France, Germany, Italy, Spain):  
€329/month
      - Group 3 (Slovakia):  
€279/month

# MOBILITY GRANTS (3)

- Students who already had an Erasmus+ scholarship before, can apply again if:
  - Previous scholarship was granted for Bachelor studies
  - Previous scholarship was granted for Master studies: sum of previous and new funding period does not exceed 12 months

# MOBILITY GRANTS (4)

- Mobility for **internship in Europe** (min. 2 months)
  - Only if **no EU scholarship**:
    - Erasmus+ traineeships (via UGent)
      - Group 1: Scandinavian countries  
€479/month
      - Group 2: (Austria, France, Germany, Italy, Spain...)  
€429/month
      - Group 3: Eastern European countries  
€379/month

# MOBILITY GRANTS (5)

- Mobility for **courses, internship or part of master dissertation outside Europe** (min. 1 month)
- Only if no EU nor VLIR-UOS ICP scholarship:
  - **Grants on bilateral agreements** (via UGent)
    - Travel grant ~ distance to destination (max €1.100)
    - + evt. monthly allowance of €650 during max. 4 months (selection based on socio-economic situation student -> to be demonstrated in application file)



## MOBILITY GRANTS (6)

- Mobility for **internship or part of master dissertation to VLIR-UOS partner country** (min. 1 month)
  - Only if no EU nor VLIR-UOS ICP scholarship:
  - Only for EU citizens
    - VLIR-UOS travel grant (via UGent – min. 1 maand)

# MOBILITY GRANTS (7)

- Mobility for **part of master dissertation in or outside Europe** (min. 3 weeks)
  - CWO grant (via FBE):
    - dissertation travel expenses

# MOBILITY GRANTS (8)

- Only for international joint masters
  - Mobility grants via UGent are possible for trips departing from all partner institutions offering the joint programme
  - the following conditions apply :
    - the student must have spent a period of study of at least one semester at UGent (exc. students having obtained a previous degree within the Flemish Community of Belgium);
    - applications for a mobility grant for a student's home country will be treated with the lowest allocation priority

# WHY SUBMIT EXCHANGE APPLICATION?

- Register your mobility
  - for safety reasons & insurance
  - for your diploma supplement
  - for mobility grant application
  - because it's mandatory... 😊

# WHEN SUBMIT EXCHANGE APPLICATION?

- For students in an international joint master:
  - Following courses at an EU diploma awarding partner (without request for Erasmus+ scholarship) → **NO**
  - Following courses at an EU diploma awarding partner (with request for Erasmus+ scholarship) → **YES**
  - Following courses at an associated partner → **YES**
  - Master dissertation partly abroad (data collection and/or fieldwork outside of host university) → **YES**
  - Internship outside of host university → **YES**



# WHEN SUBMIT EXCHANGE APPLICATION?

- For students in UGent master
  - Master dissertation partly abroad (data collection and/or fieldwork) → **YES**
  - Internship outside of Flanders → **YES**

- Application for mobility grant via UGent: **31/01/2020**
- Application for mobility grant via FBE: deadlines see [website](#) (april/sept/dec)
- Master dissertation: 4 weeks before start
- Internship during summer holidays: 01/05/2020
- Internship outside summer holidays:  
2 months before start
