



But: a lot of <u>criticism towards</u> bio (<u>even</u> stronger among believers):


- "Stories" of bad examples undermine credibility

- Global GAP & MRL limits to be respected
- 60k€ for testing & controls (300 tests)
- Max 3 residues requested to suppliers in our guidebook but today there is no legal and no scientific basis to sanction or to push suppliers
- Largest assortment BIO: ± 635 products
