

WHY GO ON AN EXCHANGE?

TYPES OF MOBILITY

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Courses

Go abroad for one semester and follow courses at one of our partner institutions.

Internship

Combine your first work experience with an intercultural experience during an internship abroad.

Master Dissertation

Go abroad for data collection or experimental research as a part of your master dissertation.

Summer/Winter school or BIP

Take a short, intensive course abroad during the lesson-free period.

Various scholarships available for exchange outside the Erasmus zone.

Two types:

1 – monthly allowance (max 4 months) & travel allowance;

2 – Travel allowance.

Distribution of grants according to the principle: the higher the socio-economic need, the higher the chance of receiving a type 1 grant (monthly allowance & travel allowance).

SUMMER SCHOOLS AND BIPS

- **What's a summer school?**


- Short exchange where you follow a FULL course/project/module at partner institution
- As an elective course in curriculum
- Study programme decides for how many credits it counts in curriculum

SUMMER SCHOOLS AND BIPS

- **What's a BIP or Blended Intensive Programme?**

- Programme (course, course unit,module) where you work with students and teachers from different institutions in a blended format (**online and physically**).
- Exchange component : minimum 5 days, maximum 30 days
- Study load: min. 3 credits = ECTS (physical + virtual component together)
 - final decision make by study programme!





FINANCIAL SUPPORT – BIPS

- Erasmus+ grant options:

- Exchanges for **5-14 days** → **€70/day** (student grant/work student: top up of €100)
- Exchanges for **15-30 days** → **€50/day** (student grant/work student: top up of €150)

TRAVEL POLICY STUDENTS

In addition to an academic and administrative permit, students must also obtain a final travel permit after a check of the (security) situation in the country/region of destination. It looks at:



The overall safety situation (e.g. political situation, civil unrest, etc.)



The general health situation (e.g. Ebola, COVID-19,...)



Measures or events, resulting in major restrictions on freedom of movement (e.g. prolonged general strikes, lockdown, etc.)




Access to a particular country/territory






The security situation in a country can be unstable (for a short or longer period of time).

Therefore, be sure to check the travel advice of your Ministry of Foreign Affairs. Be sure to check the LGBTQ+ policy on site if it applies to you.

These formulations, among others, should already set off alarm bells: "security context volatile", "increased vigilance required", "non-essential travel discouraged". Ask yourself whether it is necessary to go to that destination on exchange or internship. If not, choose a safer destination now.

If so, prepare yourself well. Be sure to have a plan B up your sleeve.
