

**Route description to the Department of Accounting, Corporate Finance and Taxation, Sint-Pietersplein 7, 9000 Gent**

Our department is situated on the Sint-Pietersplein, next to the St. Peterschurch.



**By car:**

- Follow directions to Gent and take the direction “Gent/Gent Centrum” (1.1 km). Take exit 1-“Ledeborg/alle richtingen” (820 m)..
- Sint-Lievenslaan (700 m), turn right at the traffic lights: Overpoortstraat (400 m). You arrive at the Sint-Pietersplein, park in the underground car park (P10).



## **By train to the railway station Gent Sint-Pieters**

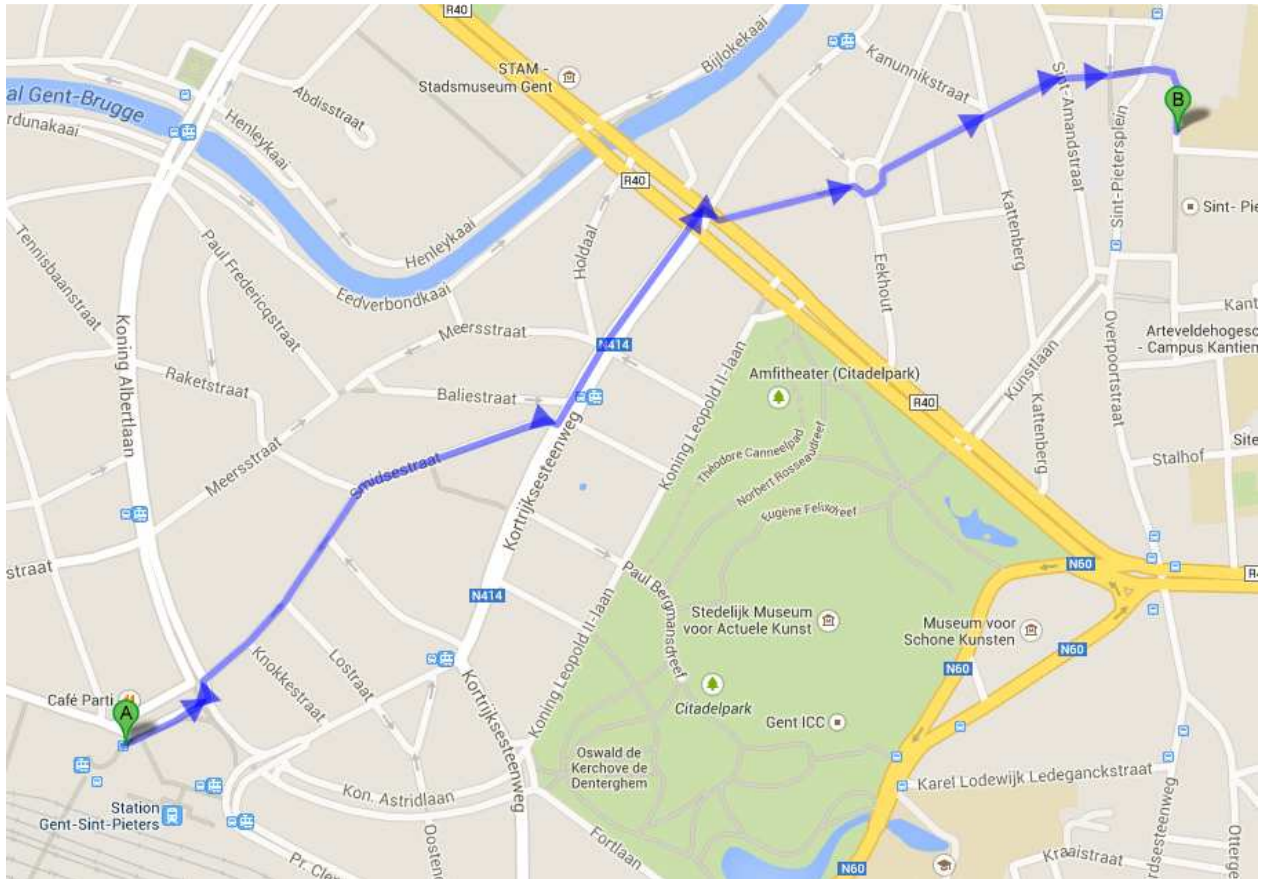
### Choice 1: on foot

Walking from the Sint-Pieters railway station to the Sint-Pietersplein takes 15-20 min.

#### Itinerary

Cross the Maria Hendrikaplein diagonally. Continue through the Kon. Elisabethlaan  
Continue through the Kortrijksesteenweg. Continue across the busy crossroads  
(Charles de Kerckhovelaan). Take the small uphill street: Laurent Delvauxstraat.  
Continue across the Prudens van Duyseplein, Jakob Jordaensstraat, Kazernestraat,  
Floribertusstraat. Cross the Sint-Pietersplein diagonally. The department is situated  
on nr. 7, next to the church.

### Choice 2: by bus:

- From the railway station Gent-Sint-Pieters  
Line 70 Oostakker / line 72 Oostakker / line 77 Beervelde : stop Heuvelpoort  
and then 450 m on foot, through the Overpoortstraat to the Sint-Pietersplein
- From Ghent University Hospital  
Line 5 Van Beverenplein: stop at the Sint-Pietersplein

### Choice 3: by tram:

You take **tram 1** direction “Evergem” or “Korenmarkt”. Get off at the third stop “Veergrep”. Return some 30 m and turn left into the small uphill street: Kanunnikstraat. Continue slightly left into the Kazernenstraat, continue through Floribertusstraat. You arrive at the Sint-Pietersplein. Cross the square diagonally, our department is situated at nr. 7, next to the church.

On the way back you can take tram 1 or tram 21/22; both trams go to the railway station Gent Sint-Pieters.
