Aitor Erce (European Stability Mechanism)

Aitor Erce is currently a Senior Researcher at the European Stability Mechanism. Before joining the ESM, Aitor was a Senior Economist at the International Affairs Directorate of Bank of Spain. Aitor holds a MSc in finance from CEMFI and a PhD in economics from the European University Institute. His interests include capital flows, international financial architecture and crises resolution. His research has been published in international peer-reviewed journals such as the Journal of Banking and Finance, the Journal of Monetary Economics, Governance or the Journal of International Money and Finance. Since 2012, Aitor is an associate researcher at the Dallas Fed's Globalization and Monetary Policy Institute and, since 2013, an affiliate researcher with Warwick University's IMF Research Network.

He has been acting as a ST Consultant for the World Bank since 2004 and served as Research Director of IRES at UCLouvain between 2008 and 2012. He edited four books and published articles in Journal of Economic Theory, Journal of Economic Literature, Economic Journal, Journal of Development Economics, Journal of Economic Dynamics and Control, Journal of Economic Growth and many other journals.
