## DEFINITION (FROM AMBA ACCREDITATION)







- The DBA is a **doctoral-level**, **research-based qualification**, designed to make a contribution to the enhancement of transdisciplinary professional practice in management disciplines, in addition to a contribution to knowledge via the development and application of theoretical frameworks, methods, and techniques.
- A DBA places emphasis on the **novel application of theory**, as well as the **potential creation or testing of theory** within the context of practice.






