

## REPORTING AN INCIDENT

Fire – Medical emergency – Agression – Power failure – Chemical spill – Theft – Leakage – ...

- Push a red warning button. 
- Contact the University's Emergency Centre: **09 264 88 88**. 
- Provide more information: Who – What – Where – Victims – Dangerous substances - ...?
- Follow the instructions of the Emergency Centre.

## WARNING SIGNAL



-----  
Audible close by the incident.

(when a red warning button or smoke detector is activated)



- Find the cause of the signal.
- Contact the University's Emergency Centre: **09 264 88 88**. 
- Report what you see, smell, hear... or ask about the cause of the signal.
- Follow the instructions of the Emergency Centre.
- Activate the evacuation alarm if necessary (by pressing the yellow button at the main entrance).

## EVACUATION ALARM



Audible throughout the building.  
When a yellow push button is activated.



- Leave the building using the nearest (emergency) exit:



- Follow the instructions of the First Intervention Team. 

- Do not use the lift. 

- Never evacuate through smoke.

- Close windows and doors, turn off electrical appliances and close gas and water taps.

- Go to the assembly point (see evacuation maps): 

- Pass on relevant information to the First Intervention Team or the emergency services.
