

How can I apply for an exchange?

a) Application deadlines

- For the period September- December: 15 May
- For the period February – June: 15 November

b) Procedure

- Check whether you met the requirements for exchange at the department of Logopaedic and Audiological Sciences (see requirements).
- If you met the requirements, complete the application procedure. Your application will only be considered if your file is complete and submitted before the application deadline.
 - Go to <https://oasis.ugent.be>. You will find general instructions in the [Oasis manual](#).
 - Once your application is approved you will receive an invitation letter, required for enrollment upon arrival.
- As part of the online application process, you will need to complete a Learning Agreement ("learning agreement for studies"), which includes selecting the courses you will follow at Ghent University.
 - An overview of the available courses can be found under the section "which courses can I select as an exchange student".
 - A standard curriculum at Ghent University consists of 60 ECTS per academic year. For your exchange, we recommend:
 - Select courses for about 30 ECTS credits per semester, with a minimum of 22 ECTS per semester. At least half of your ECTS should be taken from the Exchange Programme in Medicine and Health Sciences or courses from the department Logopaedic and Audiological Sciences.
 - The learning agreement should be filled-in, signed and stamped before arrival. You may contact the Erasmus coordinator of the program (dr. Sofie Degeest) who will discuss the courses you would like to take. Always mention whether your institution work with Erasmus without papers (EWP) or not, and follow the appropriate procedure (see: application procedure).
