

Master dissertation

Besides theoretical courses, there is also the possibility to work on a master dissertation in collaboration with your educational institution and the program in Logopaedic and Audiological Sciences.

Students considering coming to Ghent University for an exchange within our programme are only eligible if:

- you speak and write English at least at B2 level
- you are a student of 3rd bachelor level or higher

For exchange for master dissertations also the following **additional requirements** apply:

- a) You need a supervisor at your home institution and a supervisor at the Ghent University, Department of Logopaedic and Audiological Sciences. Once you have found a professor who is willing to act as your host you can submit an application.
- b) Research in the framework of your master thesis:
 - You come to Ghent University in order to conduct part of your research in the framework of your master thesis (desk research, field work, laboratory research...). In this case, a bilateral agreement between your home institution and Ghent University in your field of study is optional.
 - If you come to Ghent University to write your entire master thesis at Ghent University, including the thesis defense, a bilateral agreement with your home university is obligatory.

How can I submit an application?

- a) Since ethical clearance is required to set up scientific research in collaboration with the Ghent University, the enrolment in a joint master dissertation needs to be decided at least 6 months before arrival at the Ghent University.
- b) You need to create a Ghent University account and register via the [Oasis website](#). You will find general instructions in the [Oasis manual](#). In this procedure you need to select your faculty, the [correct academic year](#) of your exchange and choose the correct semester in which your exchange period would fall.
- c) A learning agreement is required: Please use the correct [template](#) for studies, traineeship, research in the framework of a Master thesis or exchange PhD research or short-term blended mobility (including BIP).
 - Part of the research in the framework of the master thesis: learning agreement for traineeships
 - Entire master thesis and defense: bilateral agreement is obligatory and use learning agreement for studies
