

Which courses can I select as an exchange student?

Please note that not all courses from the curriculum can be selected by exchange students. Below, there is an overview of courses that can be chosen by exchange students. You can compose your programme by combining courses from these three different options, depending on your interests and learning objectives.

a) Courses within Logopaedics and Audiology

- Most theoretical courses are taught in Dutch.
- For exchange students, lecturers will provide alternative assignments and/or adapted course materials in English.
