CLINICAL REASONING

This course consists of the following sessions/tasks:

1st semester (during the stay in Belgium)

- Information session, given by the course responsible regarding the organization of the course, group assignement, and case-presentation (first week of the academic year)
- Case-presentation in small groups, given by coach (specific for intervention area)
- Group-work, self-study, literature-study during week 3-8 of the academic year
- Coaching for the group 2 times during this period students come in their group to the REVAKI and receive feedback and coaching from the course responsibles
- Week 9-12: presentations of the cases for the students (each student presents with his/her group one case, and follows 5 others). Each presentation is followed by a practical session (concerning techniques, exercises etc... learned during case presentation.
- For each case presentation, the course responsible gives a theoretical session with scientific and clinical background of the case.

Time schedule:

- Information session: 1hCase presentation: 2h
- Group-work no time schedule
- Coaching: 2 times 2 hours
- Presentation and practice: 6 times 3 hours
- Theoretical sessions 6 times 1,5 h

2nd semester (when the student is back at his home university)

- Assignment for a second clinical case, with written report, to be sent to the course responsible. Information is given by email.

Exam (june):

- The student receives a case presentation through email. Within 3 hours the student has to describe a treatment protocol for the case presented, and send it to the course responsible.
