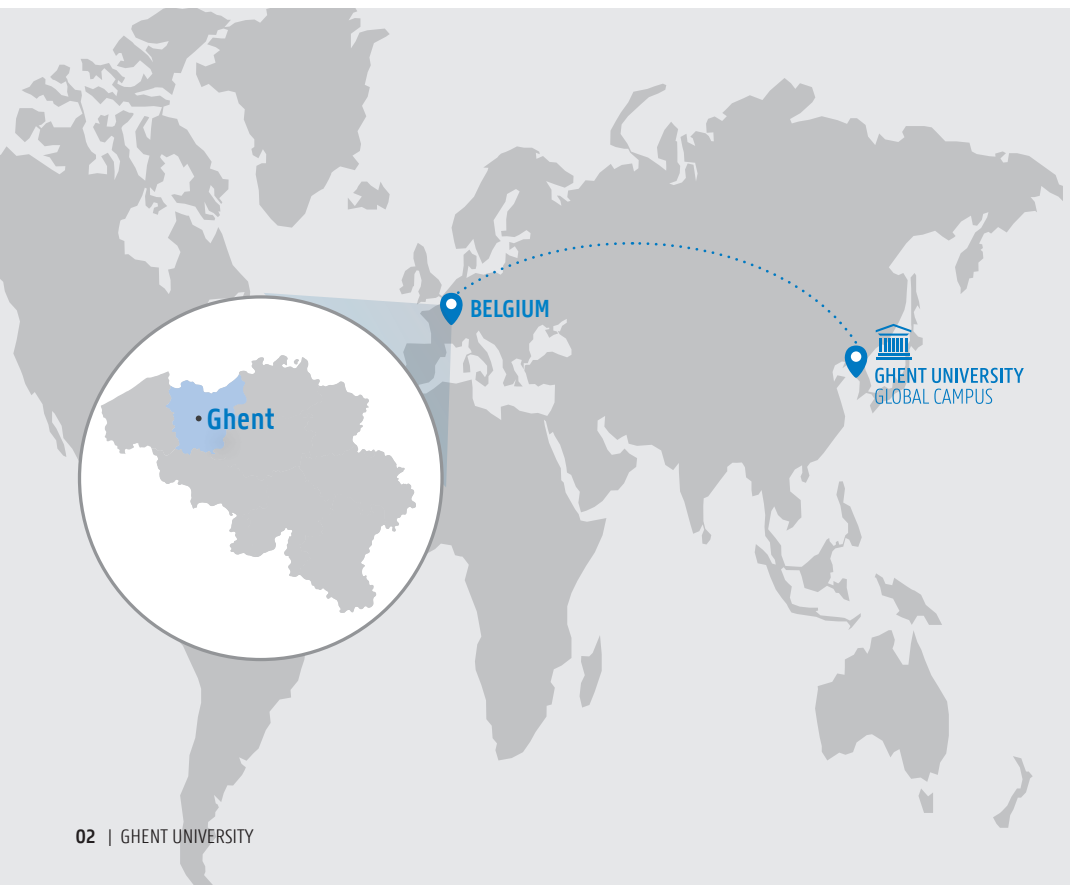

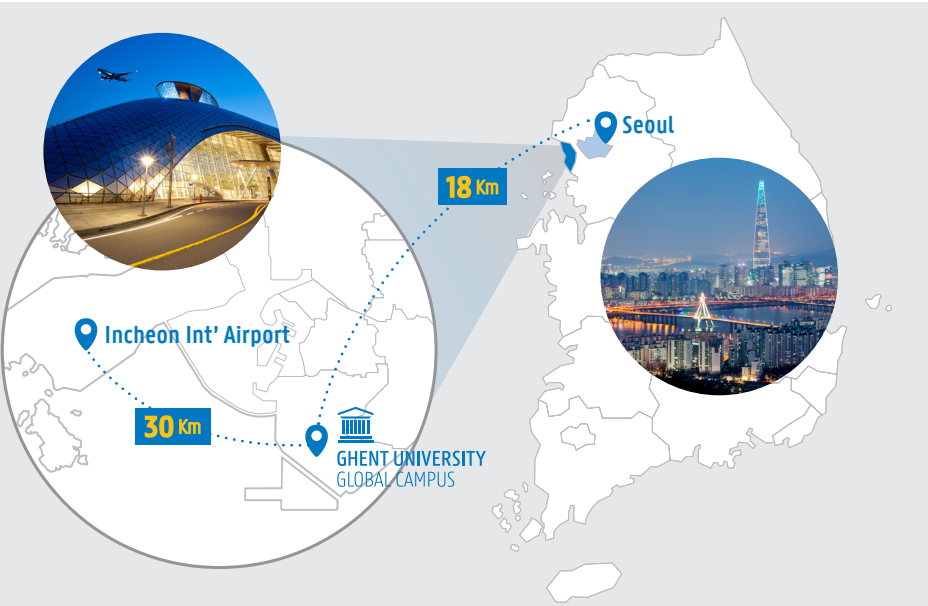

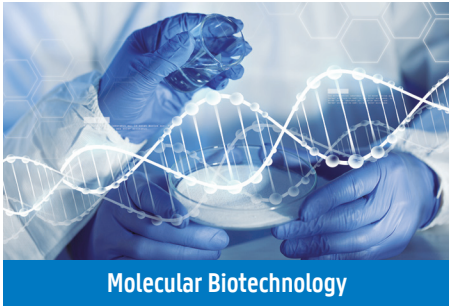

* [Eligibility for the 4-Year Scholarship] Successful completion of all courses in the previous academic year, with a minimum grade of 10 out of 20 in each course.

* [Duration of Study] Renewed annually for students starting in March; awarded for eight semesters for students starting in September.

* [Duplication] Admission scholarships cannot be combined; only the scholarship with the higher amount will be awarded.

* Scholarship details and criteria are subject to change in accordance with university policy.

* Scholarships are denominated in KRW; USD amounts are indicative only and subject to currency fluctuation.
