

Doctoral Schools

Flourishing Doctoral Schools support the PhD students during their research process and provide extensive training opportunities.

Interdisciplinary PhDs

PhD students may also opt for a PhD with an interdisciplinary character that results in a combined PhD degree, under the joint supervision of two or more UGent supervisors belonging to different disciplines.

Joint PhDs

PhD students can do part of their research at Ghent University and another part at another university. Ghent University makes it possible to award PhD degrees with other universities. Such degrees may take the form of a joint doctorate or a double doctorate (joint degree or double degree). The Ghent University Special Research Fund can offer funding to foreign students who qualify for this.



VISITING RESEARCHERS

Our faculty is committed to international and national knowledge exchange. Post-doctoral researchers and senior academics are invited to join our research groups for several months, e.g. in the framework of a specific research project or for the purpose of a more structural cooperation between researchers.
