EU Window Scholarship - Frequently Asked Questions

1. Am I eligible to apply?

Please refer to the **Eligibility** section in the official notice.

Note: Scholarship recipients **cannot** receive other Chinese government-funded scholarships at the same time.

2. Can I apply to universities in Hong Kong or Macau?

No. This scholarship is only valid for Mainland China.

3. How do I choose universities and majors?

Search available programs at www.campuschina.org, and check the websites of target universities directly.

4. Is an Admission Letter necessary?

Yes. Applicants are **strongly encouraged** to contact universities early.

Accepted documents: Admission Notice / Pre-admission Letter / Supervisor Acceptance Letter.

5. Do I need to take the CSCA test?

Yes, undergraduate applicants must submit CSCA test results from 2026/2027.

Details: www.csca.cn

6. I will graduate in June/July 2026. Can I apply now?

Yes. Upload a pre-graduation certificate (with school stamp/signature) and your latest transcript.

7. What should I include in my Study/Research Plan?

Include: motivation, research interest, study plan, and why you chose the university.

Length:

Undergraduate: 200+ words Non-degree: 500+ words Postgraduate: 800+ words

8. In which language should I submit my documents?

All documents must be **in English**. If originals are in another language, provide official certified English translations with the originals.

9. Do I need a physical examination?

Yes. Upload the **Foreigner Physical Examination Form** with photo and doctor/hospital stamp/signature.

Validity: 6 months.

10. Where do I apply?

Apply online via the CSC System: https://studyinchina.csc.edu.cn

Program Category: Type A / Agency Number: 00006

11. How many universities can I apply for?

You may see three options on the system, but **only the first choice will be considered.**Once submitted and reviewed, **no university change is allowed**.

12. Do I need to send any paper documents?

No. Online submission only.

13. What is the application deadline?

February 8, 2026.

Apply early— Chinese universities close for winter break in late January.

14. Why are some applications not admitted?

Common reasons:

- Incomplete documents
- Not meeting eligibility/university requirements
- Limited university places

15. When will results be released?

Usually July - August. Check results in your CSC online account.

16. How do I receive my admission documents if selected?

You will download them directly from the CSC system.
